



JOURNAL INFORMATION

The Columbia Police Association of Nassau County Commemorative Journal has been the single most production of revenue for our association since its debut in 1992. The Journal was first started by then 1st Vice President, Robert F. Cariola assisted by then Recording Secretary, Carmine E. Soldano. Since 1992, the Committee Chairman has been Carmine E. Soldano and it has been published every two (2) years in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance. The only exception was our planned 2002 issue that was delayed to February 2003 due to problems with a caterer the association originally intended to use that year.

The purpose of this Association publication is multi-faceted. First and foremost, it raises revenue in the form of advertisements for our organization and provides Scholarship money. The Association also utilizes the journal to acknowledge the current Executive Board of Officers, past and present Association Presidents, and past and present Honorees. In general, this publication has been very successful with the help of our fraternal supporters and outside supporters.

1992 – First Edition

This was the Associations first attempt at publishing a Commemorative Journal. The journal was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 16, 1992 at the Suffolk Manor Caterers in North Lindenhurst, NY. This issue contained 16 pages excluding the cover.

1994 – Second Edition

This was the Associations Second edition and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 13, 1994 at the Westbury Manor in Westbury, NY. This was the first time we utilized a comb binding on our journal. The journal contained 30 pages excluding the cover and the pages were printed in blue ink. Biographies of the Executive Board were added for the first time.

1996 – Third Edition

This was the Associations Third edition and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 25, 1996 at the Manor East Caterers in Massapequa, NY. This was the first issue with the newest Association Logo. The journal

contained 40 pages excluding the cover and the pages were printed in blue ink. This issue was the first journal to contain Gold and Silver advertisement pages. There were 28 white pages, 8 Gold pages, and 4 Silver pages.

1998 – Fourth Edition

This was the Associations Fourth edition and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 16, 1996 at the Imperial Manor Caterers in Bethpage, NY. The journal contained 56 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 40 white pages, 8 Gold pages, and 8 Silver pages and the pages were printed in black ink. This issue was the first journal to publish photographs of the Executive Board Members along with their respective biographies.

2000 – Fifth Edition

This was the Associations Fifth edition and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 22, 2000 at the Vanderbilt in Plainview, NY. This publication was the first to have color encompassing the whole cover in the colors of the Italian Flag. This was the largest publication thus far and the journal had first the first time a glued binding to accommodate the thickness of the publication. The journal contained 80 pages. There were 64 white pages, 8 Gold pages, and 8 Silver pages.

2003 – Sixth Edition

This was the Associations Sixth edition and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on February 13, 2003 at the North Ritz Club in Syosset, NY. This dance and journal, originally scheduled for the fall of 2002, was delayed to February 2003 due to problems with a caterer the association originally intended to use that year. Ultimately, the dance was run in conjunction with Valentines Day. The journal contained 40 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 32 white pages, 4 Gold pages, and 4 Silver pages. All pages were printed in black ink with a red border.

2004 – Seventh Edition

This was the Associations Seventh edition and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on November 04, 2004 at the North Ritz Club in Syosset, NY. This was the publication's first cover with both the American and Italian Flags included with the Association Logo. The journal contained 92 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 76 white pages, 8 Gold pages, and 8 Silver pages. All pages were printed in black ink with a blue border.

2006 – Eighth Edition

This was the Associations Eighth and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 13, 2006 at the North Ritz Club in Syosset, NY. This was the publication's first cover with the font in the Italian colors help making the cover look more festive and the back cover in color. The journal contained 88 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 64 white pages, 16 Gold pages, and 8 Silver pages. All pages were printed in black ink with a red border.

2008 – Ninth Edition

This was the Associations Ninth and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 23, 2008 at the North Ritz Club in Syosset, NY. This was the publication's first cover with the new association logo and with green and red vertical borders. The back was given a green and red order for the first time. The journal contained 96 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 66 white pages, 22 Gold pages, and 8 Silver pages. All pages were printed in black ink with a green border.

2010 – Tenth Edition

This was the Associations Tenth and was published in conjunction with our Installation Dinner Dance held on October 27, 2010 at Oheka Castle Hotel & Estate in Huntington, NY. This was the publication's first cover with 15 photographs and a picture of the Association Insignia Bar. This was the largest and most successful journal to date. The journal contained 116 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 84 white pages, 2 Color Pages, 20 Gold pages, and 10 Silver pages. All pages were printed in black ink with a red border and red association logo.

2012 – Eleventh Edition

This was the Associations Eleventh and was published in conjunction with our 50Th Anniversary Installation Dinner Dance originally planned for October 24, 2012 but was held on November 19th, 2012 at the North Ritz Club in Syosset, NY. This cover was in Gold for the 50Th Anniversary. The journal was very successful considering the poor economy. The journal contained 104 pages excluding the cover pages. There were 80 white pages, 4 Color Pages, 14 Gold pages, and 6 Silver pages. All pages were printed in black ink with a red border and red association logo.
